New water rates effective Nov 1st

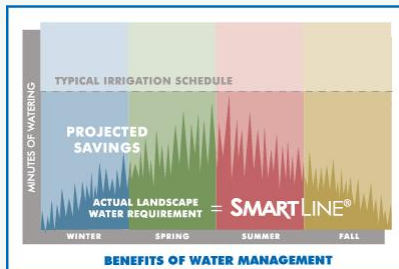
